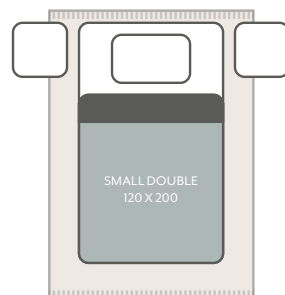
INCORRECT PLACEMENT



Never use a small rug as an island with just a coffee table sitting on top. Sofas and armchairs should always overlap the rug by either $\frac{1}{3}$ or $\frac{2}{3}$ of their depth.



Dining chairs should always sit on the rug when pulled out from under the table, otherwise the legs will catch on the rug when pulling the chairs in.



Beds should always overlap the rug by at least $\frac{2}{3}$ of their length. You should also ensure that there's enough rug visible at the sides of the bed.
